On April 22, 2019 Henry Harrison passed away at The Jackson-Madison County Hospital with his beloved wife by his side.

Henry founded the International Rockabilly Hall of Fame in 2001 and maintained it right up until his death. Thousands of tourists from all over the world toured the Hall of Fame, were entertained by Henry's personal stories and early years with many of the rockabilly artists. Presently

there are over 7,000 signatures on the walls of the museum, placed there by visitors from countries outside the US as well as those from most every state in the US.
